

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF MODIFICATION ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF RIGHTS OF WAY FOR SHROPSHIRE

THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (BRIDLEWAY ADDITION, PARISH OF WEM RURAL) MODIFICATION ORDER 2013

On 19th December 2013 an Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above named Order. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by

adding a Bridleway from point A on the Order Map (SJ 5275 2823) where it leaves the County Road (Barker's Green Lane) running in a general east-south-easterly direction as an enclosed unsurfaced lane for approximately 245 metres then turning in a general north-north-easterly direction for a further 270 metres approximately to point B on the Order Map (SJ 5312 2837) where it meets the County Road; a total distance of approximately 515 metres with a width varying between 4 metres and 14 metres as shown on the 2nd 1:2500 Edition Ordnance Survey Map.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at the Council offices at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours. Copies of the Order and map may also be bought from Shropshire Council at the above address at a price of £6.50.

The Order becomes operative as from 19th December 2013, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Section 53 or 54 or that any of the requirements of Schedule 15 have not been complied with in relation to the Order he may, under paragraph 12 of Schedule 15, within 42 days from the date of publication of the notice make an application to the High Court.

This Order is made by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the Council that the Shropshire Definitive Map and Statement require modification because in accordance with the provisions of Section 53(3)(c)(i) the Council has discovered evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows:-

- (i) that a right of way which is not shown on the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic

The Council hereby order that:-

1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 1st February 2013.
2. The Shropshire Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Bridleway Addition, Parish of Wem Rural) Modification Order 2013.

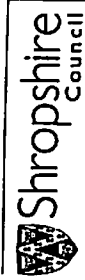
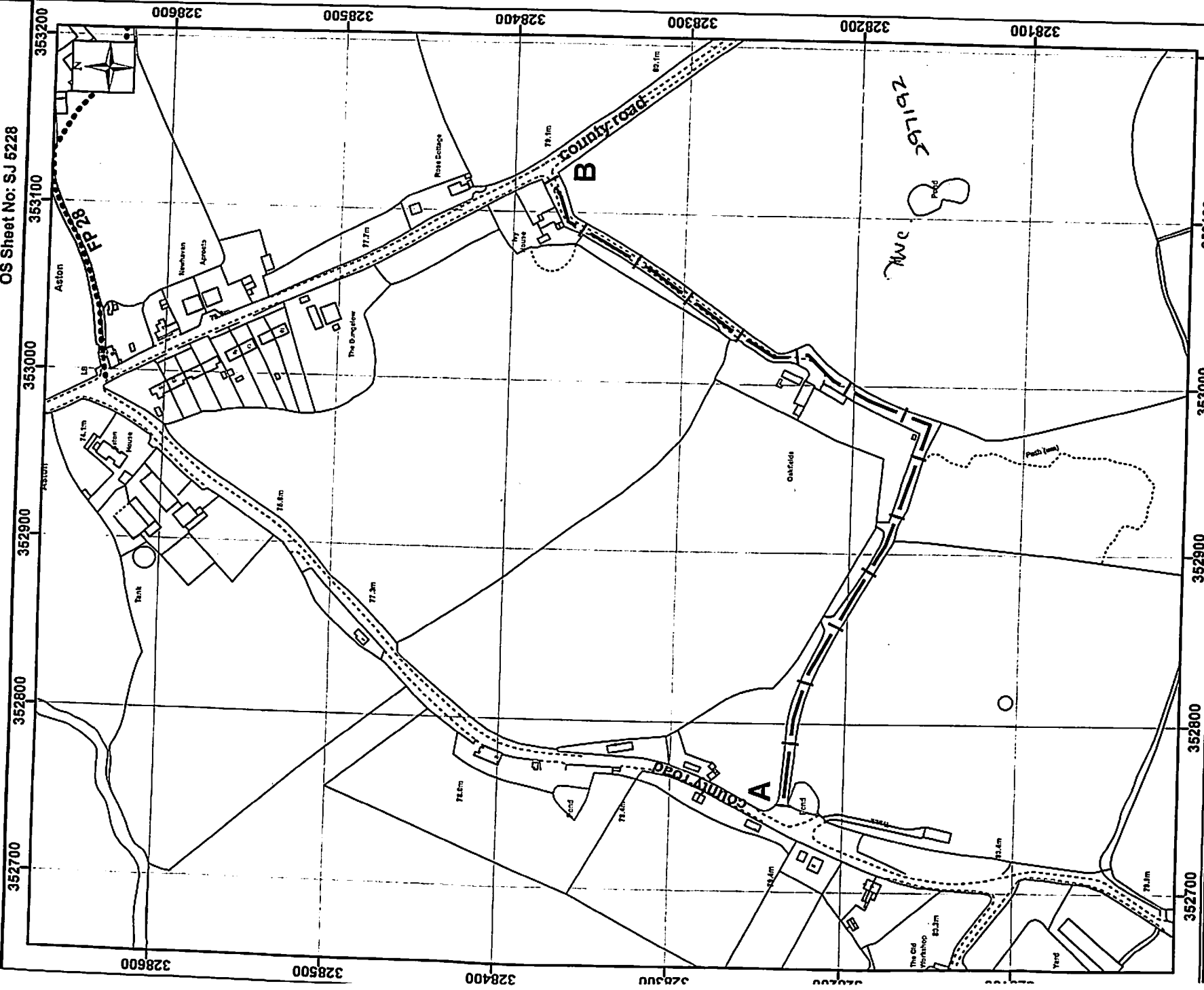
