



Q2 In your opinion, is your present accommodation adequate for your household's needs?



Q3 If in your opinion, your present accommodation is not adequate for your needs, what are the reasons?





Q5 Are you currently registered on the Homepoint Housing Register?



Q6 Do you own property or land that you might be willing to see built on or developed for affordable housing?



Q7 Would you like to see some more housing in the parish over the next ten years?



Q8 Would you be willing to see some open market housing development in order to fund affordable housing development?





Q10 What size of housing might be appropriate?



Q11 How many dwellings might be appropriate (over the next 19 years)?



Q12 Where should any new housing be developed?






