Local Connection Appeals Process

**To be read in conjunction with the document titled:
Roles and Responsibilities of
Sevenside Housing, Wem Rural Parish Council
and Shropshire Council.**

This process was adopted at the meeting held on 5 May 2015

The Council is committed to dealing with all applications to confirm local connection fairly and impartially.

If the person seeking to have his/her local connection confirmed is not happy with the decision made by the Parish Council then he/she should write formally to the Parish Council via Sevenside Housing outlining the reasons for his/her dissatisfaction. At this point, he/she may also consider providing additional or alternative independent evidence of their local connection.

If the appeal is received no less than 10 days before the next Parish Council meeting then the Parish Council will consider the appeal at the next Council meeting without the presence of the press or public. Any appeal received less than 10 days before a Parish Council meeting will not be considered until the following Council meeting again without the presence of the press or public. The Council will advise Sevenside Housing of the decision as soon as possible.

This process relates purely to the confirmation of local connection. The Parish Council is not a consultee or party to any decision made by Sevenside Housing on any other aspect of the tenancy application/agreement.
